Saturday, Aug. 2—Meet at James St. carhouse, New Haven, Conn., (upper level) at 9:30 a. m. for tie hauling and track repair on Branford Electric line.

Sunday, Aug. 3—Don't forget "Valley Branch" steam excursion trip this date.

Saturday, Aug. 9—At Warehouse Point—Continuation of work on No. 10, station, and track construction.

Sunday, Aug. 10—Providence trolley and trackless trolley trip by Southern New England Chapter.

Saturday, Aug. 16 and Sunday, Aug. 17—At Warehouse Point—Alternate date for renewal of roof canvas on No. 10 if the

weather is wet or threatening on July 26-27 weekend. Otherwise, repainting of No. 10 will be started; also further work on station and track extension.

Saturday, Aug. 23—Meet at James St. carhouse, New Haven, Conn. (upper level) at 9:30 a. m. for track work on Branford Electric line.

Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Aug. 30-31-Sept. 1—NRHS Convention in Boston.

Saturday, Sunday, Monday, Sept. 6-7-8—Annual visit and work on Seashore Electric line in Kennebunkport, Maine.

Repair work and painting of Car No. 10 will be supervised by Fred Bennett, station construction by Robert Pratt, right-of-way engineering by Henry Stieg, and track building by Richard Whittier. On Branford Electric, track work will be in charge of Roger Borrup.

We expect each of our members to do some work on the project at least one day during the summer, so please consider this schedule carefully and select a date that will be most convenient for you.
